

Our plans to improve your local road network

Our plans to improve the A12 and A120 are coming your way. In Summer/Autumn 2018, Highways England will be carrying out essential maintenance and minor improvement works to the A12 between Ingatestone and Ipswich.

Safety is a top priority for Highways England and this programme will improve both safety and journey quality for road users.

This programme includes resurfacing, renewing road markings, reflective road studs, maintenance works to signs and safety barriers along with maintenance of bridges and technological renewals.

Resurfacing and renewal of road markings and reflective studs

- A12 Junction 19 – Crix Bridge
- A12 Junction 20 – Junction 22 – Hatfield Peverel

Widening of entry slip road, renewal of road markings and signs

- A12 Southbound Coleman's Off and On Slip road

- A120 Crown Interchange to Hare Green – Eastbound and Westbound
- A12 Junction 15 – Junction 17

Technological renewals

- A120 Coggeshall – renewal of electronic sign
- A120 Horsley Cross – renewal of weather station

- A120 Blackwater Bridge
- Queensborough Bridge
- A12 Motts Bridge
- A120 Fox Street Bridge
- A14 Claydon Interchange

Maintenance works

- Renewal of safety barrier terminals, signs and traffic detection loops at - A12 Junction 29 to Junction 30 - Colchester
- Renewal of safety barrier terminals and signs - A120 Horsley Cross to Hare Green
- Renewal of safety barrier terminals, signs and traffic detection loops at A12 – Junction 19 – Crix Bridge
- Renewal of safety barrier terminals - A12 Junction 22 – Junction 23 – Witham

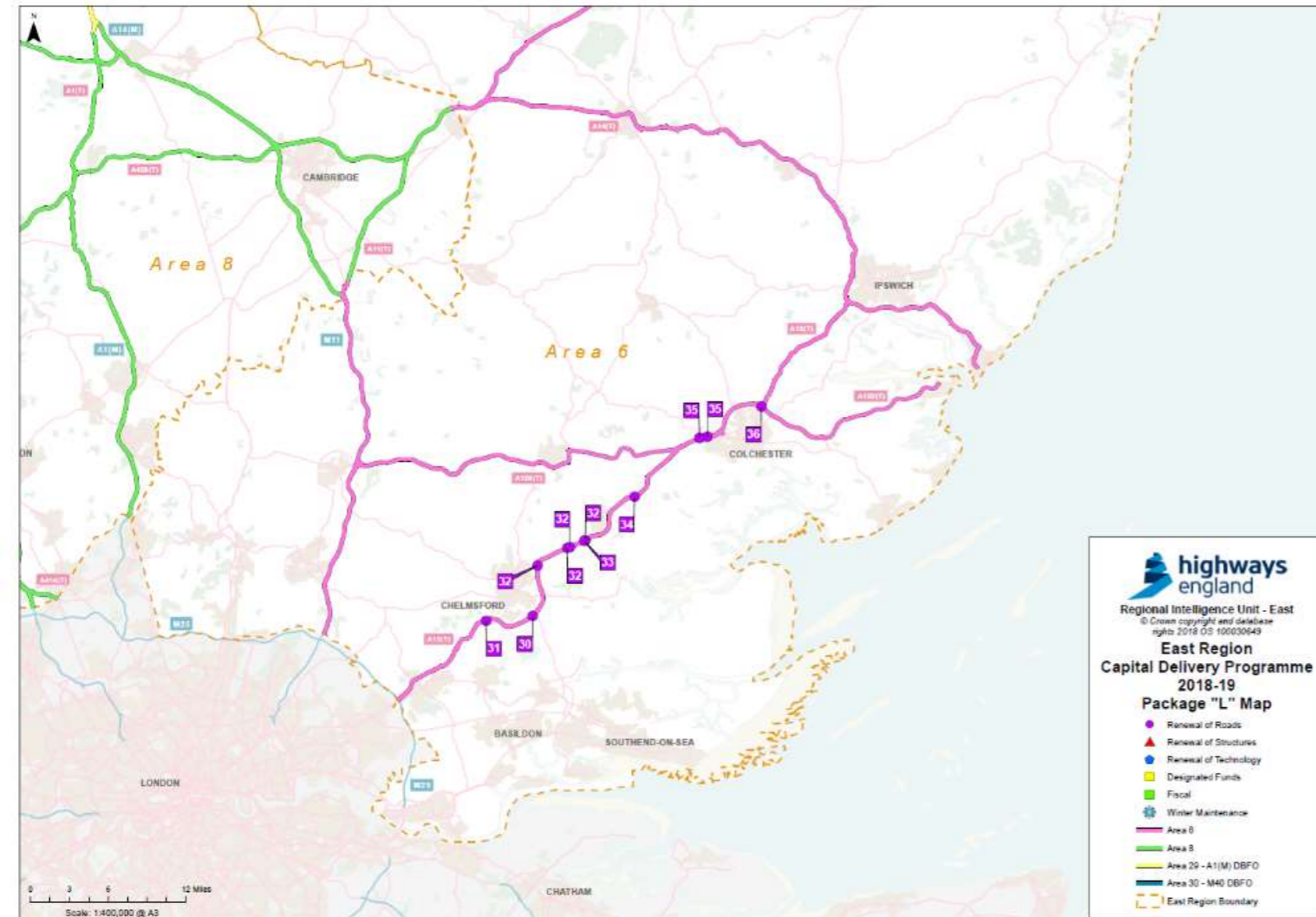
Location plan
